- Materials are compressed to as little as 10% of traditional protection methods when discarded at the end of a build



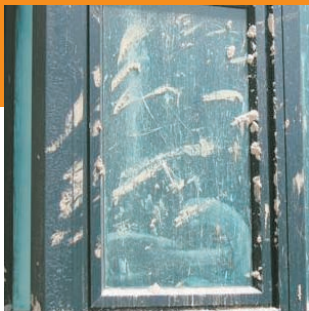

construction phase. Virtually eliminates all non mechanical damage all the way through to the final inspection.

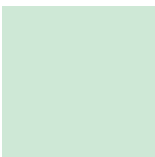

Products are applied using roll coating, brush, spray or dipping (at the fabrication stage).



Glasstrip Advanced is a weather resistant strippable protective coating for protecting glass and both Aluminium and PVC frames used within the construction industry. The skin tight 'plastic' film will offer resistance to abrasion and overspray of solvent paints and rendering during the construction process for periods of up to 12 months.

Glasstrip may also be used to 'opaque' glass windows for a temporary period. The product is specially formulated to provide good early onset water resistance, and good UV ageing properties.



- **Multi-Surface** is a general purpose temporary coating for protecting virtually all non-porous surfaces including plastics/acrylics, tiling, work surfaces, marble, stainless steel, concrete, paintwork and lacquered flooring. This tough, durable, skin-tight coating will resist paint and adhesive overspray.

- **Tiles and flooring**

The Protective Skins range includes a product formulated for maintenance and temporary protection of industrial floors; ceramic, porcelain and marble tiles. Protects against damage such as scratches from machinery or boots, tool boxes and splatter from construction coatings.



- **Bathtubs, showers and screens**

Provides temporary protection for most sanitary fixtures. Best applied at the joinery factory, or immediately after bathroom suite has been installed. The non-hazardous nature of products allows for safe application in confined spaces.
